
understanding the user interaction with knobs and sliders planning the assembly and detailing build exploring various on/off options

### features

textured rays to indicate brightness level

indent for easy sliding tactile ridges for rotating




### how it works


**TURN ON** - slide red knob up to turn on and yellow "ON" switch will rotate to left

ADJUST LIGHTING: slide red knob up or down to brighten or dim light


**TURN OFF** - slide red knob down and rotate yellow switch to its "OFF" position, completing the interior circle design
